### **GOLDEN JUBILEE ANNIVERSARY OF WANNEROO RACEWAY – HERITAGE CAR DISPLAY**

On March 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> this year, the WA Sporting Car Club is celebrating a very special occasion in the history of WA Motorsport, the Golden Anniversary of the first public race meeting at Wanneroo/now Barbagallo Raceway, on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 1969.

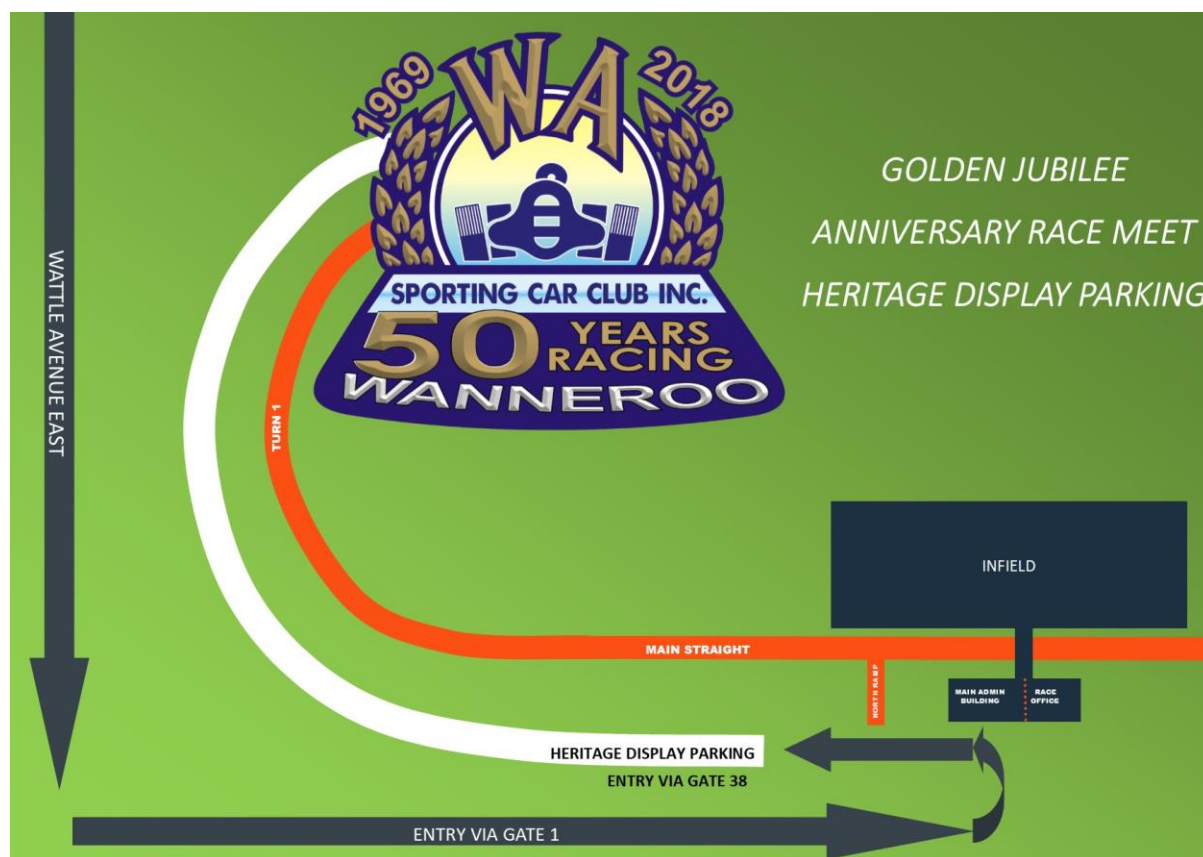

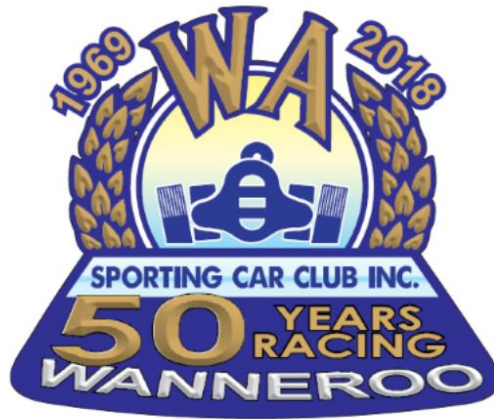
Please can you RSVP via the attached form by 11<sup>th</sup> February 2019 for the purpose of ensuring enough space is allowed specifically for your club.
