

Concessional Licensing (Code 404) July 2018

JCCWA Procedures

Eligibility for 404 Concession

1. Vehicle at least 25 years old.
2. In original condition.
3. May qualify under 25 years if considered unique.
4. Owner remains a member of an authorised club, eg JCCWA.

Process to obtain 404 if Currently Fully Registered in WA

1. Have vehicle viewed for originality by Boyd Kolozs who will issue a CMC1 Form.
2. Purchase HISTORIC stickers from Boyd Kolozs at \$20 per pair, pay \$25 for Boyd's inspection, pay \$25 annual concessional admin fee.
3. Take the following to a DoT Licensing Centre:
 - CMC1 Form – statement of membership and vehicle originality (Issued by Boyd).
 - E81 Form – 404 Concession Application Form.
 - Current vehicle licence papers.
 - Proof of identity.
4. Advise JCCWA Concessional Registrations Officer when vehicle has been placed on concession and confirm registration number.

Process to obtain 404 if Not Currently Licensed but was Previously Registered in WA

1. Have vehicle inspected by JCCWA authorised examiner at Boyd Kolozs' premises (which is the authorised inspection station) – inspection not required if vehicle registration has lapsed for less than 3 months.
2. Purchase HISTORIC stickers from Boyd Kolozs at \$20 per pair, pay \$75 for authorised examiner's inspection, pay \$25 annual concessional admin fee.
3. Take the following to a DoT Licensing Centre:
 - VL1 Form - Certificate of Inspection.
 - CMC1 Form – statement of membership and vehicle originality.
 - E81 Form – 404 Concession Application Form.
 - Proof of identity.
4. Advise JCCWA Concessional Registrations Officer when vehicle has been placed on concession and confirm registration number.

Process to obtain 404 if Never Previously Registered in WA (ex East or Imported)

1. If Build date is before 1/1/1970, have vehicle inspected by JCCWA authorised examiner at Boyd Kolozs' premises.
2. Purchase HISTORIC stickers from Boyd Kolozs at \$20 per pair, pay \$75 for authorised examiner's inspection, pay \$25 annual concessional admin fee.
3. Take the following to a DoT Licensing Centre:
 - VL1 Form - Certificate of Inspection.
 - CMC1 Form – statement of membership and vehicle originality.
 - E81 Form – 404 Concession Application Form.
 - Proof of identity.

4. Advise JCCWA Concessional Registrations Officer when vehicle has been placed on concession and confirm registration number.
5. If build date is 1/1/1970 or later, have vehicle inspected for a 404 concession at DoT's Welshpool Vehicle Examination Centre Station and proceed as per item 3 above (CMC1 Form and HISTORIC stickers will be issued by JCCWA Concessional Registrations Officer who will arrange with you for payment for stickers and \$25 annual concessional admin fee).

Process to Transfer a Currently Registered 404 Vehicle Between Owners

1. New owner must be a member of a Code 404 participating club, such as JCCWA (Join JCCWA if not, if the vehicle is to be listed with JCCWA).
2. If/when the new owner is a member of JCCWA contact Boyd Kolozs for an "originality" inspection. Pay \$25 for Boyd's inspection, pay \$25 annual concessional admin fee.
3. Take the following to a DoT Licensing Centre:
 - CMC1 Form – statement of membership and vehicle originality (Issued by Boyd).
 - E81 Form – 404 Concession Application Form.
 - Current vehicle licence papers.
 - Proof of identity.
4. Advise JCCWA Concessional Registrations Officer when ownership transfer has been completed.

Key Points of Maintaining Your 404 Concession

2. You must be a member of a Code 404 approved club, such as JCCWA, at all times
3. Your vehicle registration must be carried with the vehicle at all times.
4. You MUST pay your membership fees by the DUE DATE (30 June each year for JCCWA), THERE IS **NO** GRACE PERIOD. Pay the \$25 concessional admin fee (per vehicle) along with club fees.
5. Immediately after 30 June the JCCWA Concessional Registrations Officer is required to advise CMC who will advise DoT of any owners of Code 404 vehicles who have become non-financial (expect correspondence from the DoT).
6. When your membership lapses, your vehicle licence and most likely all insurances also lapse.
7. You must advise the JCCWA Concessional Registrations Officer each year by 30 June that your vehicle is still on concession and confirm its registration number.
8. You must advise the JCCWA Concessional Registrations Officer if your vehicle registration number changes, you place the vehicle back onto full licence or you sell the vehicle.
9. You must only use the vehicle in accordance with the usage permitted as outlined in the CMC Code 404 Information Booklet.

Process to Place a Code 404 Vehicle back onto Full Licence

1. If the vehicle has been previously fully licensed in WA, go to a DoT Licensing Centre and pay the necessary fees and additional licensing costs to fully register the vehicle.
2. If the vehicle has not previously been fully licensed in WA it will require a DoT inspection and then payment of the necessary fees and additional licensing costs to fully register the vehicle.
